#### **How** we want to reach it:






# The Energy Union The 2016 PINC

- Provides transparent and forward-looking information on pan-European investment needs
- Helps understanding of the full nuclear lifecycle in the context of post Fukushima safety requirements
- Contributes to Member States decisions on energy mix




## **Projection of nuclear capacity PINC 2016**






## **2016 Reference Scenario** *Gross Electricity generation by fuel type*






## 2016 Reference Scenario Projection of key policy indicators
